

Development Trends of Ecotourism and Geotourism in Vojvodina

There are a lot of protected natural assets in Vojvodina that were declared ecologically, socially and economically significant. The economic interest is partially related to tourism presentation of the protected natural heritage. Although ecotourism is not fully developed as a form of tourism, it takes a significant place in planning sustainable development of protected natural assets. In order to fully develop ecotourism it is necessary to intensify protection, involve local communities as important elements of sustainable tourism industry and create distinctive tourism products which promote nature protection. Since the most important geoheritage elements of Vojvodina are situated within protected natural assets, it is evident that geotourism represents a significant aspect of their tourism offer. These two growing forms of tourism can play more important parts in the tourism offer of Vojvodina than they previously used to.
